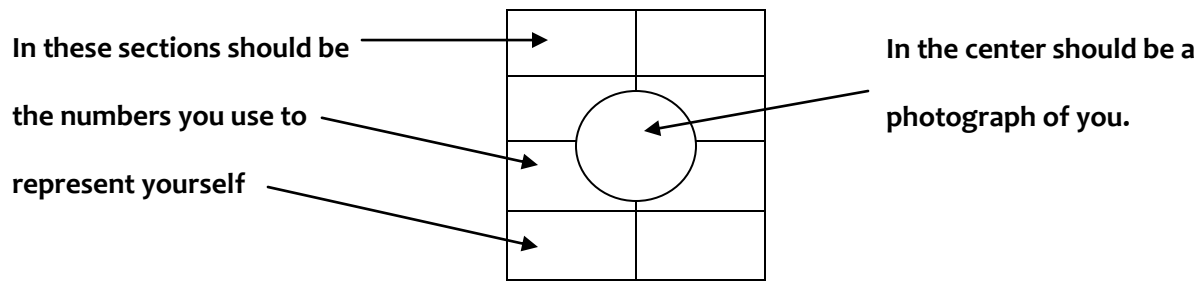


Math About Me Poster

What are the numbers of your street address?

Have you visited somewhere ~ a lot? How many times?

Examples to show extended thinking:

How many months old are you?
How many days old are you?
Year you were born in expanded form.
What fraction of your name are vowels?

What fraction (or decimal number) of your family are you?
What fraction of your year have you spent in school?
How many days have you been in school - since kindergarten?
What percentage of the alphabet is in your name?
